- Focus on the development of the skills and expertise of the presenters of the junior doctor education program (both face-to-face and virtual)
- Provide support, training and feedback to supervisors of junior doctors
- Support the implementation of the National Framework for Prevocational Medical Training
- Focus on cultural safety of our junior doctors, supervisors and patient care
